FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS REGARDING 2011 AMDA/IPA PATIENT AND SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE

QUESTION: Is there a fee to attend the Conference?

ANSWER: No. There is no fee to attend the Conference if you **register by**

September 8th, **2011** <u>and</u> are registered with the AMDA or are a member of an IPA Affiliate Member Organization (<u>click here for a list of IPA Affiliates</u>). To register with the AMDA, please complete the Registration form on our website (<u>AMDA</u>

Registration Form).

Starting September 9th, there will be a late fee of

\$15/person to register.

QUESTION: I heard that the AMDA will pay for one hotel room per patient

registered with the AMDA. How will this work?

ANSWER: The AMDA will pay for one room per patient (at the rate of

\$112/night) for up to three nights. This is non-transferable. If you will only need a room for 2 nights, you CANNOT give the

other night to someone else.

Also, there are limited funds available, so the funds will be made available based on the order in which people register for

the Conference.

Finally, **the AMDA will pay for the room charge ONLY**– any room service, amenities, or other items charged to the room are the sole responsibility of the patient.

QUESTION: If the AMDA is paying for my room, do I have to make my own reservation?

ANSWER: YES. Each patient is responsible for making his or her own reservation with the hotel. The AMDA will not be making any reservations.

To make your reservation online, please visit: Online hotel reservation link (Group Code "AMD"). To make your reservations over the phone, call + 1 (888) 615-0726 or (210) 224-2500 and ask for Lisa or Lindsay and say that you are registering with the "AMDA Patient Conference."

QUESTION: How do I know if my hotel room will be paid for by the AMDA?

Answer: Funds will be made available based on the order in which people register for the Conference (please note that funds are only available to people who have registered with the AMDA). When you receive your registration confirmation you will be told whether you have registered in time.

QUESTION: Is a reduced airfare rate to San Antonio available?

ANSWER: No.

QUESTION: Will the AMDA be providing transportation to and from the airport?

Answer: No. Each guest is responsible for arranging his/her own transportation from the airport. To assist you in making your arrangements, please consult the information below. Please note that the San Antonio International Airport is located approximately 10 minutes from the hotel.

If you are able to walk or use a walker/cane:

- Taxi from the airport will be approximately \$15 (one way)
- Shuttle from the airport will be approximately \$14 (one way).
